Club Health & Safety Policies

PURPOSE

Being totally committed to the Health & Safety of its members, the Cambridge University Handball Club considers it good practice to operate in accordance with the following guidelines; which have been produced by the Cambridge University Handball Club Committee, with reference to existing guidelines of the England Handball Association.

GUIDELINES

Committee's role in observing H&S guidelines

All committee members are responsible that the Club makes the best efforts to follow the ensuing guidelines.

Coach/Responsible Person

At all training sessions and trips a coach or nominee will clearly be labeled as being in charge.

First aid arrangements

1. All trainings and matches are being held at venues with qualified First Aid staff.
2. The Club ensures that it has members with First Aid qualifications, although it cannot guarantee that one of them is present on all occasions.
3. The Club encourages its members to use the First Aid courses offered by the Athletic Union and Living Sport.

Accident & Emergency Procedures

If an accident happens the accident and emergency procedures of the relevant Sports Centre are to be followed.

Communication

This policy is to be made available to all members of the Club.
